What's Bulk Waste?

Large and small household appliances (none containing freon), furniture, mattresses and carpet, large cardboard boxes, tree limbs less than 8 ft. long (no need to bundle) Fencing

How Much Bulk Waste is OK?

Up to six cubic yards – <u>about the size of six clothes dryers or 3</u> <u>refrigerators.</u> If you have more than 6-yards, you can take extra bulky waste to East Oak Landfill at NE 36th and Sooner for an additional fee.


Also, remember to have your bulky waste at the curb by 6:30 Monday morning, keep bulk waste 10 feet away from overhead obstacles, and 5 feet away from mailboxes, trash carts, parked cars, etc. Please keep big junk in the yard and not in the street. It's best not to park in the street on collection day.

What's Not Collectible?
