What is it? With the Auto draft, payment of your monthly utility bill is automatically deducted from your bank account on the 10th of every month.

How does it work? You will continue to receive your monthly bill as in the past. It will say "PAID BY DRAFT - DO NOT PAY" and this amount will be deducted on the 10th of the month.
