

When a Water Main Leak Is the City's Responsibility:

Your front yard might have a manhole or similar structure that houses meters designed to measure water use. There's a pipe going from these meters out to the water main, and it usually runs underneath the street. A water main is simply a large pipe that connects to your internal service pipe, which carries water from the main to your home.


When a leak occurs, the city is usually responsible for any leakage that occurs between your water meter and the water main. The only exception would be if you don't maintain the area in and around your water meters. These meters are crucial to ensuring your water supply, and they must always be accessible to the city

When a Water Main Leak Is Your Responsibility:

Did you know that as a homeowner you own the water service lines running through your front yard? In that respect, you are responsible for the part of the service line that extends from your water meter to your home. If you detect a leak anywhere in your yard, it's usually your responsibility to have the issue taken care of. That means calling a plumbing expert to get the job done.

Some signs of a water main leak in your front yard include wet spots or pools of water on the ground, sinkholes, rust, or dirt in your water supply at home or even an unusually high-water bill. If you detect a leak, shut off your water main and call a plumber as soon as possible. The earlier a leak can be detected can lead to less damage to your home, your property, and your neighbor's property.

TIRE RECYCLE

If you or someone you know has old tires that need to be discarded in a safe and environmentally friendly way, you can drop them off any time at the Spencer PW barn, located at 3550 McCoy Drive, 73084. Tires MUST be recyclable and follow these requirements:

- No tires with rims will be collected during the event.
- No tires will be collected from any other source or event. (such as tire dealerships, salvage yards, service stations, etc.)
- No exempt tires will be collected. (such as forklift, offroad, heavy machinery, backhoe tires, etc.)
- D. No tire shreds, pieces, burnt tires, or commingled trash will be accepted.
- Tires must be rollable and will only be collected for specified reasons.

What's Bulk Waste?

Large and small household appliances (none containing freon), furniture, mattresses and carpet, large cardboard boxes, tree limbs less than 8 ft. long (no need to bundle) Fencing

How Much Bulk Waste is OK?

Up to six cubic yards – about the size of six clothes dryers or 3 refrigerators. If you have more than 6-yards, you can take extra bulky waste to East Oak Landfill at NE 36th and Sooner for an additional fee.

Also, remember to have your bulky waste at the curb by 6:30 Monday morning, keep bulk waste 10 feet away from overhead obstacles, and 5 feet away from mailboxes, trash carts, parked cars, etc. Please keep big junk in the yard and not in the street. It's best not to park in the street on collection day
