

The **Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP)** is a federal program that helps improve the health of low-income seniors by supplementing their diets with nutritious USDA commodity food. Once a month, qualifying participants receive a 30-pound box of shelf-stable food and USDA cheese.

To qualify, individuals must be at least 60 years of age, provide identification, be an Oklahoma resident within the Spencer area and have a household income that does not exceed 130% of the Federal Poverty Income Guidelines.
