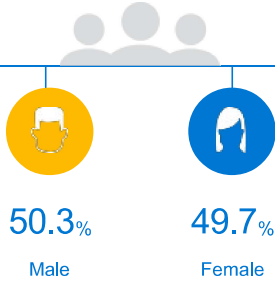

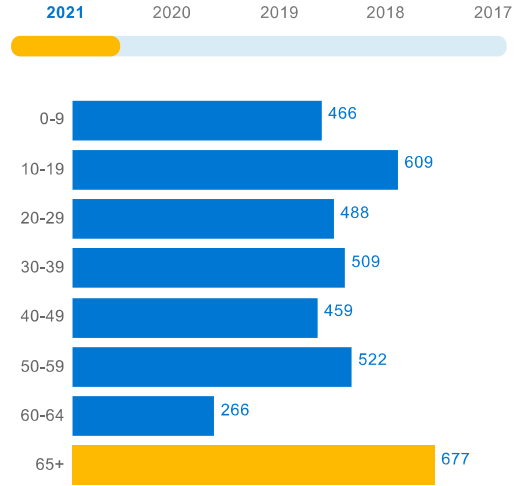

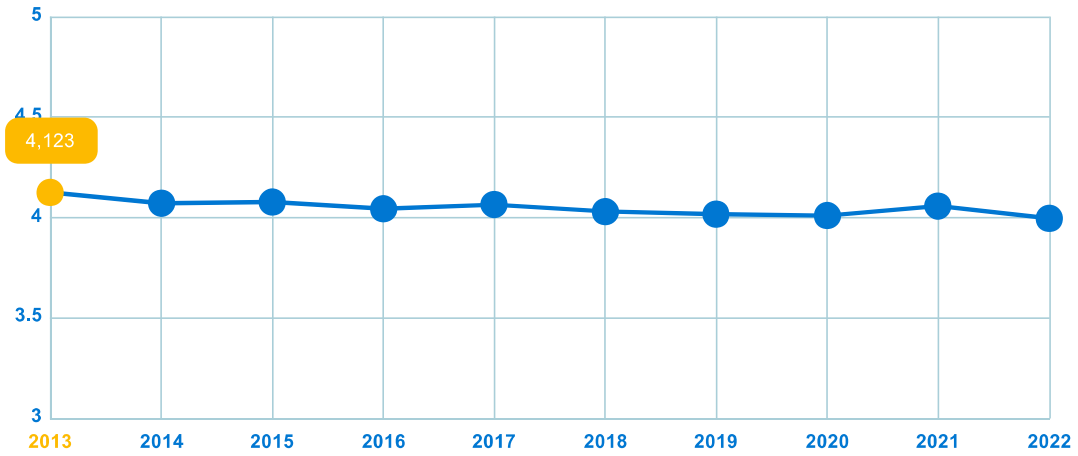
Age Distribution

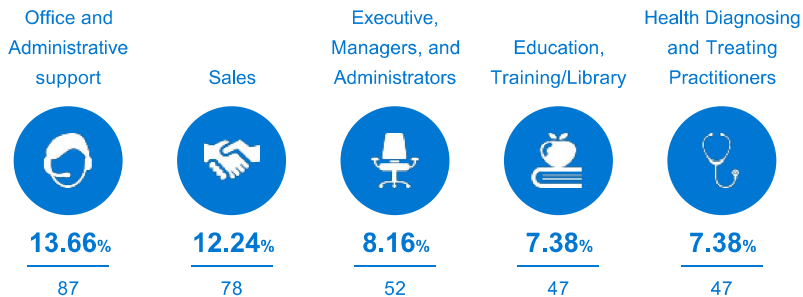

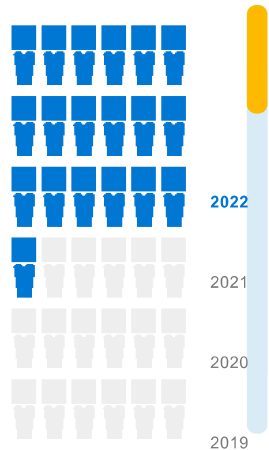

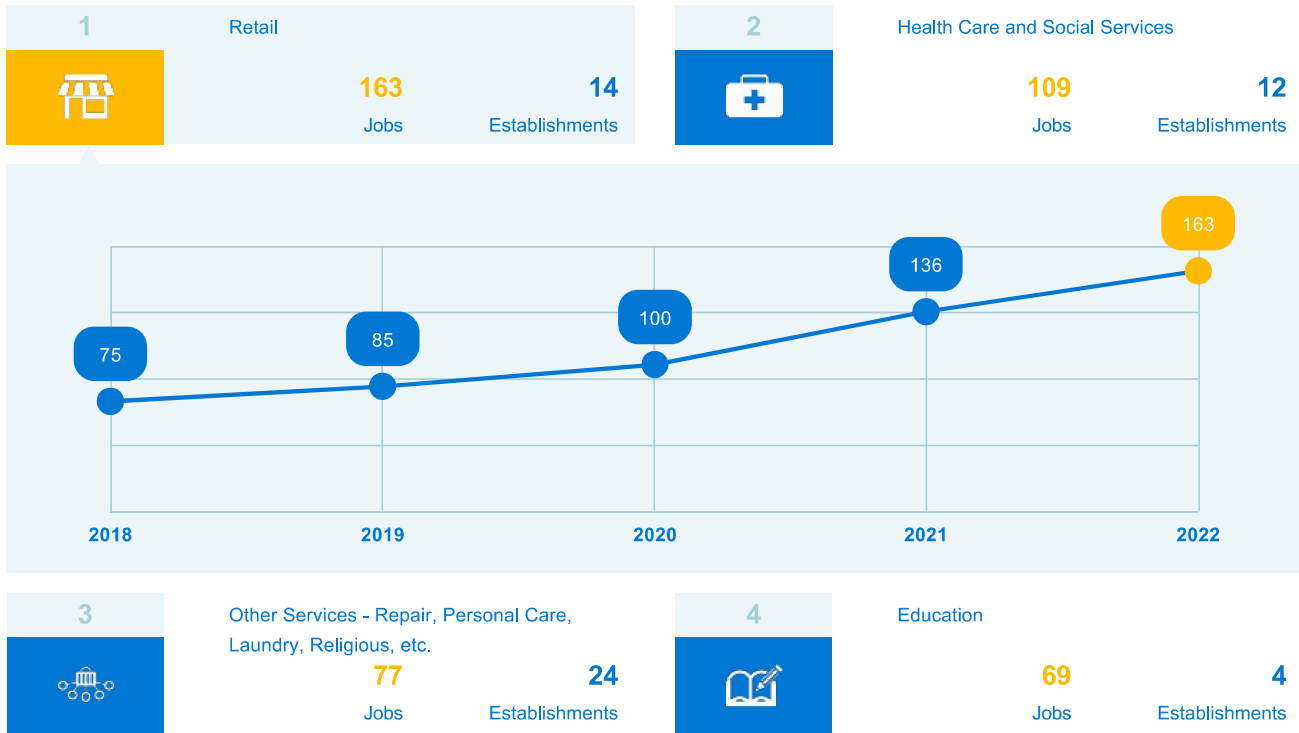

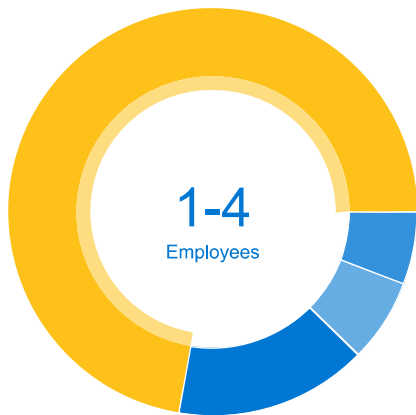

How many employees do businesses in Spencer have?

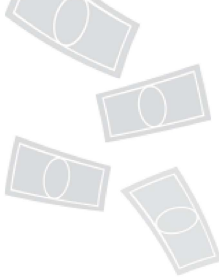

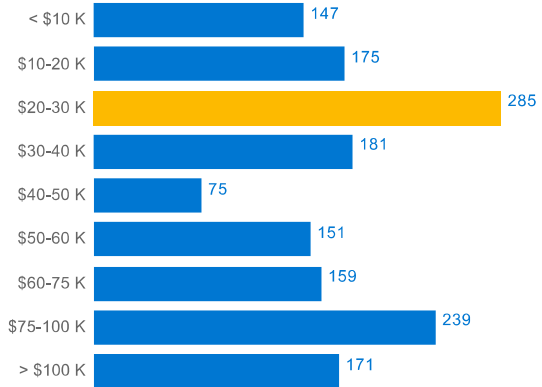

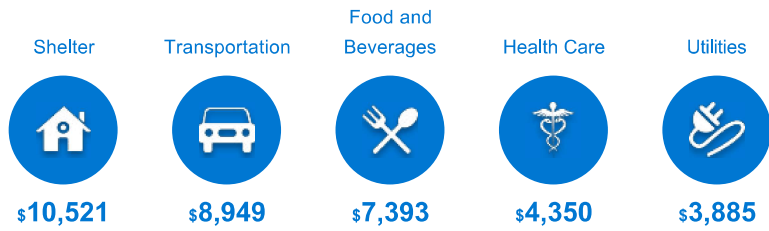

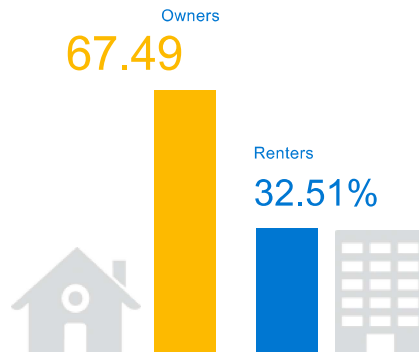
